Curriculum

OHLA uses a skills-based curriculum, focused specifically on developing necessary linguistic skills in five major areas: reading, writing, listening, speaking and grammar. We, at OHLA, know that the best way to develop these skills is to do it in a “natural” way, the same way we all learned our native languages.

We believe that languages are not meant to be memorized, but rather to be used and practiced on a daily basis in order to maintain continuity and be mastered quickly.



LEVELS OFFERED

At OHLA, mastery of the English language is not viewed as a step-by-step approach, but rather as a continuous and progressive process in which international students are challenged as they move through their levels of language study.

New languages are continuously learned and improved upon, the same way in which we are always learning and improving our native language. The main reason for this is that languages are always evolving; just like everything else we see or experience in life.

CLASS SIZE

Our average class size is 12 students. However, our classrooms can easily accommodate 15 students. This small setting maximizes interaction and allows students to receive the individual attention required in a successful student-centered curriculum



Faculty

Every member of our faculty holds a Bachelor's Degree and are all certified to teach ESL. They have gained ESL qualifications through postsecondary studies or specialized training courses. Besides looking for individuals with the required educational background, we seek teachers who have international experience and, as such, a number of our faculty members have had previous teaching assignments abroad. The diverse educational backgrounds of our teachers provide students the benefit of various teaching styles and experiences.

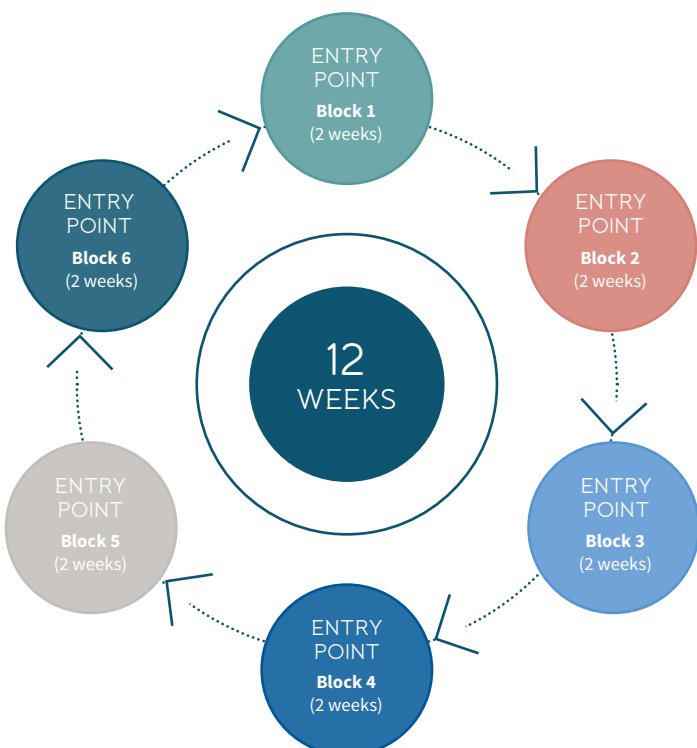


Entry Point and Placement Test

Each level lasts 12 weeks and is sub-divided in six 2-week-units called "blocks". Students may commence their language studies at the beginning of any two-week block. For instance, if a student were to start at the beginning of the third week (beginning of the second block), he or she would complete the remaining 5 blocks, make up the work missed from the first block, and would only be promoted to the next level upon achieving a passing average score in all the assessment tools (such as the biweekly block exams).



While the blocks are designed to be as self-contained and as non-cumulative as possible, it is inevitable that the material will build on itself to some degree, resulting in a progression of skill development, which will maximize the students' learning experience.

STUDENT VISA (F1 VISA)

OHLA is authorized under Federal Law to sponsor foreign students. Upon receipt and acceptance of an application we input information in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS), and then issue an I-20 Form, which is needed to obtain a student visa (F1). Students must schedule an appointment with the nearest US Embassy, present the I-20 Form and passport, pay the necessary visa fees, submit the required forms for a Student Visa and show evidence of financial support. Additionally, students must be able to prove to the Consular Officer that they have strong ties to their home country.

CONVERSATION CLUB

Our conversation club gives students the chance to practice the language outside of class. Whether students are trying to learn to speak more formally or just want to talk with people of similar interests, our Conversation Club provides an excellent opportunity for students to further immerse themselves in their practice of English. The Conversation Club is FREE and does not require registration. Students just have to join in and have a good time!

ENGLISH ONLY POLICY

OHLA's goal is to facilitate the constant practice of English. As such, an official English Only Zone has been established at OHLA. This zone includes offices, computer labs, classes, student lounge and common areas. Upon entering this zone, students, faculty and staff are required to speak English only. Clear signs are displayed throughout the school that continuously remind students and staff of the importance of using English only in their daily interactions.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Students under the F1 Visa must carry medical insurance for the length of their studies. OHLA is pleased to offer its very own comprehensive emergency/medical insurance coverage with GUARD ME, the world's largest insurance provider for students.

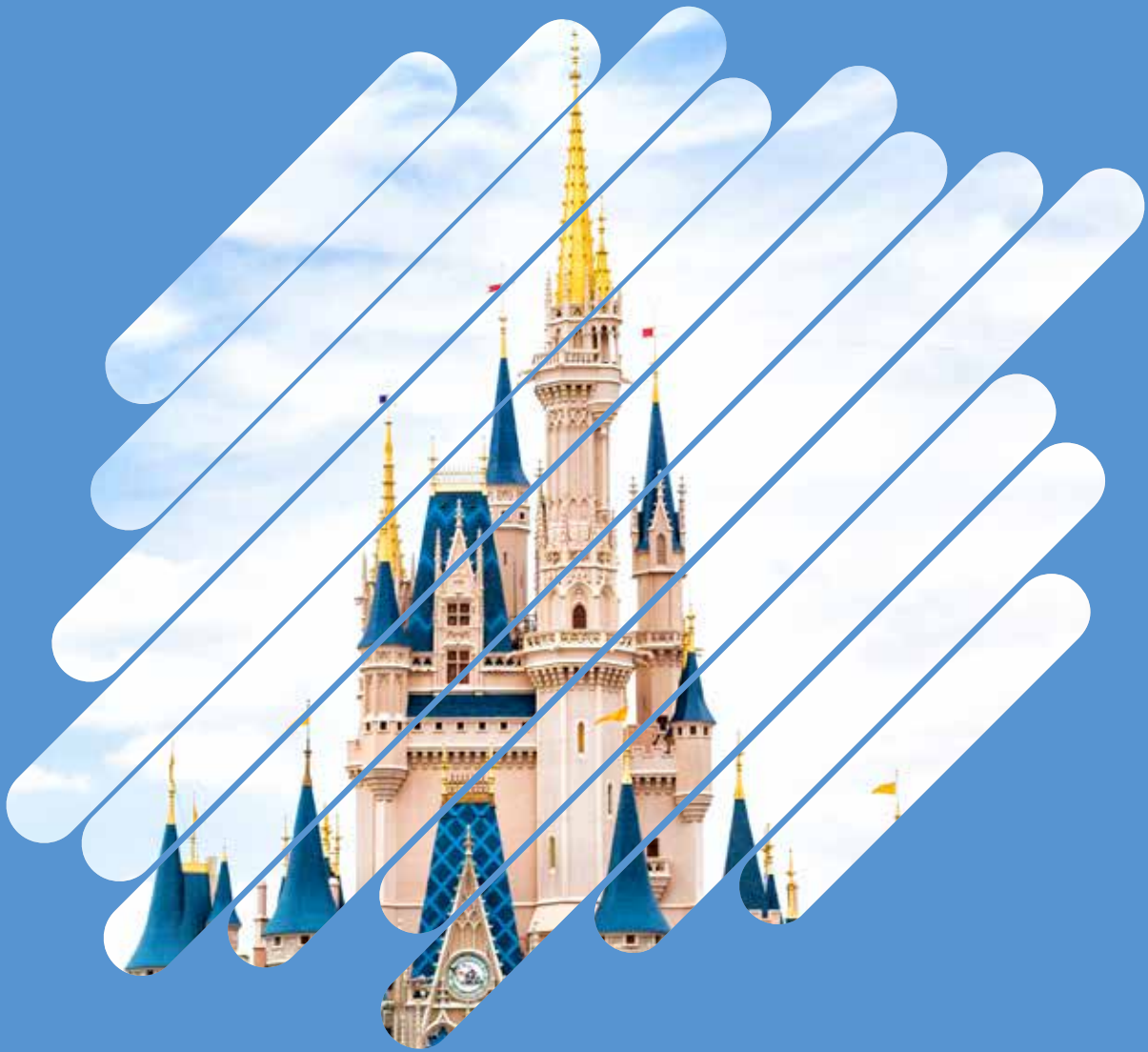
